Cost: \$825 per student for council members, \$990 for non council members. This includes instruction, book with online access, materials and t-shirt.

What to know:

You are about to embark on a 60-hour training program to prepare you to become an Emergency Medical Responder within the State of Washington. You will also be expected to study on your time outside of class. This will include reading the textbook, knowing and understanding definitions as they pertain to the training program, knowing and understanding the equipment used in emergency medicine, practicing the practical skills expected of an EMR. Your personal time will need to be dedicated to the training program at the expense of your personal social life at times during the class.

By signing the application, you are accepting the requirement to attend all classes on the schedule, devoting the time required and spending the time needed to study and practice for a successful outcome.

1. Students will need to bring their own working lunch and snacks.
2. Students must have access to a working computer. All homework and module, midterms and finals exams are done online.
3. **For Mason County students, EMR are required to participate in the Mason County ongoing training education program (OTEP). You will be responsible to complete 6 one-hour classes per year with accompanying test. These are all done online, with the practical test being done at your station.**
4. Students will be expected to do an in-hospital rotation and a ride along field rotation in order to graduate the class.
5. In order for students to have their National application signed off by Mason County MPD, they must have one passing practice National.
6. The class must have 6 students registered at the time of deadline to commence.

Class Requirements:

1. Pass midterm and final test with 80% or above.
2. Students must maintain an 80% average in homework and are allowed only three retakes throughout the course.
